



## PROGRAMS ANNOUNCED FOR MOONSTONE BOOKSTORE IN RED CLOUD, NEBRASKA

Today, though she is busy being a wife, mother, and farmhand, she looks forward to leaving a legacy of her writing for the generations to come.

The next event will be the second session of The Moonstone Bookstore's Cone-flower Book Club. The group will be reading *Tuesdays with Morrie* by Mitch Albom, the best selling book about the famed sports writer and his reunion with his favorite professor and mentor. Full of lessons about life, the club will be exploring various issues that the book raised. The club will meet on Wednesday, October 24 at the bookstore, at 10:30 a.m. and then at 7:00 p.m. to accommodate people who work during the day.
